

<u>What you will need</u>

- 2 card board circles
- I roll of wool
- 1 pair of child friendly scissors

<u>Step 1</u>

Take the wool and wind it around till its thick with wool.

Tip: Don't wrap it too tight because it might make it harder to cut.





<u>Step 2</u>

Cut the string off the rest of the wool and put the rest of the wool aside.

<u>Step3</u>

- Put the scissors in between the 2 pieces of card at the end, then cut along the wool.
- Tip: Hold all the wool in middle of the small hole and don't let go.





<u>Step 4</u>

Take some more of the wool and wrap it in between the two pieces of card and tie in a knot.

Tip: Do 2 or 3 knots to make it more secured.

<u>Step 5</u>

Remove the card from both sides of the bobble.







Cut both bits of string off and tidy it up by cutting any bits that are too long.

All done!!


